MEDICAL CONDITIONS

GENERALLY AGGRAVATED by EXPOSURE: Skin and eye inflammation, dizziness, respiratory tract irritation and other lung conditions.

EMERGENCY AND FIRST AID PROCEDURES

EYE CONTACT: If splashed into eyes, rinse eyes with large amounts of water for at least 15 minutes or until irritation subsides, and get immediate medical attention.
